

IRREGULAR VERBS

These verbs are irregular verbs. You cannot just add *ed* to them to make them past tense. You must memorize these irregular verbs in their present, past, and past participle forms.

<u>Verb</u>	<u>Past</u>	<u>Past Participle</u>
Become	became	(Has) become
Begin	began	(Has) begun
Be	was	(Has) been
Blow	blew	(Has) blown
Break	broke	(Has) broken
Bring	brought	(Has) brought
Buy	bought	(Has) bought
Choose	chose	(Has) chosen
Come	came	(Has) come
Do	did	(Has) done
Drink	drank	(Has) drunk
Drive	drove	(Has) driven
Eat	ate	(Has) eaten
Fall	fell	(Has) fallen
Fly	flew	(Has) flown
Freeze	froze	(Has) frozen
Get	got	(Has) gotten
Give	gave	(Has) given
Go	went	(Has) gone
Grow	grew	(Has) grown
Know	knew	(Has) known
Lie	lay	(Has) lain
Lay	laid	(Has) laid
Make	made	(Has) made
Ride	rode	(Has) ridden
Ring	rang	(Has) rung
Rise	rose	(Has) risen
See	saw	(Has) seen
Sell	sold	(Has) sold
Sing	sang	(Has) sung
Sink	sank	(Has) sunk
Sit	sat	(Has) sat
Shoot	shot	(Has) shot
Swim	swam	(Has) swum
Take	took	(Has) taken
